## LOT 1080

A 19th century silver and enamel cased oval pendant watch, probably Austro-Hungarian, with unsigned fusee movement, the case interior, exterior and dial with enamelled decoration, painted with religious scenes, length 4.8cm.

## Condition Report

1080. The movement is not running at all and we do not have a key small enough to try winding it.

Dial in generally good condition with only typical minor surface scratches and wear.

Silver case in generally good order with typical surface scratches and wear. Some minor loss to blue enamelled decoration. The enamelled front of the case has been restored and colour has 'yellowed' a bit, there is also a small chip near to the hinge.

The inner case enamel in good condition, and back case enamel also in good order with only typical surface scratches and wear, but colours are vibrant with no significant damage or repairs.
