A late 19th century French gilt metal and porcelain mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the porcelain dial with black Roman hour numerals and floral centre within a bleu céleste band, the urn surmount painted with a scene of a cupid and putto within gilt framing on a bleu céleste ground, above scroll supports and flower festoons, on a bowfront base, the case back stamped 'P.H Mourey 75', height 38.5cm, with pendulum and giltwood stand, together with a pair of similarly decorated ewer shaped ornaments, stamped 'P.H. Mourey', heights 30cm, with giltwood stands.

Condition Report

1137. Both ewers have chips around the porcelain necks. Otherwise ewers in okay order with typical wear to gilt and painting. Typical light surface scratches. Metalwork on all pieces is worn and also dusty and dirty. All would benefit from a clean.

Clock case in generally good order.

Movement does not wind or run.

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
