A gold, opal and diamond ring, circa 1910, claw set with three oval opals alternating with two rows of three rose cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 2.8g, ring size approx N1/2, with a case.

Estimate: £180 - £220

Condition Report

One side oval is chipped to the underside edge. The other side opal has a chip beneath one claw. Otherwise the opals have slight surface wear and one of the diamond points is damaged. The mount is otherwise in fairly good condition.

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
