A Victorian gold, imitation pearl and taxidermy hummingbird bar brooch, the front applied with a taxidermy head of a hummingbird, unmarked, weight 5.1g, length 5.4cm, a 9ct gold, red gem and diamond bar brooch (one diamond lacking), weight 2.5g, a gold, platinum and green tourmaline stickpin, detailed '14K Plat', weight 2.8g, and two further stickpins, one detailed 'Tiffany & Co'.

Condition Report

Hummingbird brooch - the taxidermy hummingbird head is in fairly good condition. At the back of the brooch there is a dent at one end by the hinge. The metal is a little discoloured. Also the edge of the mount at the back of the hummingbird's head has been bent over and there is also a split at this point.

Red gem brooch - a little dented at the back, the hook of the clasp has been later added, the hinge pin is bent, one rose cut diamond lacking, overall a bit tarnished. Birmingham 1900.

Tourmaline stickpin - the tourmaline is of medium to pale colour saturation. In generally good condition,

Tiffany & Co stickpin - the drop shaped pearl in good condition, overall good condition, length 6.8cm.

Half-pearl stickpin - in good condition.
