A Victorian silver Albert pattern caddy spoon with scallop shell bowl, Exeter, no date letter, by Josiah Williams, length 10.3cm, a silver rectangular snuff box, the hinged lid with gilt roundel, initial engraved, with all-over engraved ivy leaf decoration, Birmingham 1884 by Hilliard & Thomason, length 5.3cm, a silver curved rectangular card case, Birmingham 1911, length 8.2cm, a silver circular box and cover, Birmingham 1917 by Horace Woodward & Co Ltd, diameter 6cm, and a small group of other silver items, including a napkin ring, a filigree card case, a filigree pillbox and a pendant mount and chain, weighable items 173.2g.

### Condition Report

367. Caddy spoon - good condition, typical surface scratches and wear. Good clear hallmarks, but missing date letter.

Rectangular snuff box - good condition, typical minor wear to engraving, hinge is good and lid closes tightly. Initialled gilt panel to top. Good clear hallmarks.

Circular box - minor dents to sides, small dent to top of lid, typical light surface scratches and wear. Lid fits tightly. Good clear hallmarks.

.800 bangle - good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear. Good clear marks.

Curved card case - good condition, typical light surface scratches and wear, no significant damage or repairs. Good crisp engraving. Initialled panel. Hinge is good. Good clear marks.

Filigree card case - generally good clean condition, typical minor wear. Hinge is good and cover closes tightly.

Small filigree box - good condition, typical light wear. Hinge is good and closes tightly.

Pendant - good clean enamelling and in good condition.
