A set of six Victorian silver salts and four matching salt spoons, each salt of circular form with a shallow bowl decorated in relief with foliate panels beneath a beaded rim, raised on a tapering stem and similarly decorated circular foot, Sheffield 1865 by Martin Hall & Co, total weight 305.8g, height of salt 3.8cm, cased.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

379. All six salts in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. All a bit dirty and would benefit from a clean. Four interiors with typical scratching and wear, the other two have more significant wear/scratches to interiors.

Four spoons in good order (two missing). Good clear hallmarks.

Case has wear and scuffs, but otherwise ok.
