LOT 1499

Three Royal Worcester cabinet cups with matching milk jug and sugar bowl, 1919 to 1930, each painted by E. Barker, signed, with sheep in landscape settings, gilt lined, puce printed marks to bases (one cup cracked), together with a similar gilt lined cabinet cup and saucer, painted by Stinton, signed, with Highland cattle.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

Jug - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, a couple of tiny and indistinct scratches to painted decoration.

Sugar bowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

3 sheep cups - 2 in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. One with 2 bad cracks and heavily crazed.

3 sheep saucers - one heavily crazed, otherwise each in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Each has light typical surface wear to the gilt wells.

Stinton Highland Cattle cup and saucer - both heavily crazed but otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
