A French Japonaise pottery ormolu mounted table lamp, probably Longwy, the pear shaped body of 'cloisonné' style, decorated with blossom branches against a pale blue ground, the ormolu foot with lion masks supporting laurel garlands, height to top of rim mount 40cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

The mounts have not been removed but the vase would appear to be in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, with typical intended crazing to the glaze.

The gilt metal mount around the foot of the vase has a number of small vertical cracks to its edge, not affecting the ormolu foot.

Would need rewiring.

The vase does sit at a slight angle.
