A Chaffers Liverpool porcelain Jumping Boy pattern saucer, circa 1756-60, pseudo underglaze blue painted Chinese character marks to base, diameter 12.2cm, together with a Liverpool porcelain small mug, painted with a chinoiserie landscape, height 6.7cm, a moulded teabowl and saucer, painted in underglaze blue with floral panels, diameter of saucer 13cm, and another teabowl (minor faults).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Jumping Boy saucer - light typical surface scratches to glaze, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Mug - firing haircrack to top of handle, 2 small chips to inner rim edge.

Moulded teabowl and saucer - 3cm vertical haircrack to rim of saucer with 2cm haircrack branching off, teabowl has 2.5cm long vertical haircrack to rim.

Other teabowl - 2 long vertical haircracks to rim, one of which branches off horizontally.
