### LOT 1617

A small group of Worcester underglaze blue decorated porcelain, 1770s, comprising a Mansfield teapot and cover and two teabowls, a Feather Mould Floral teabowl, a Fence pattern jug and cover, height 12.5cm, a Three Flowers pattern coffee cup and saucer and a fluted coffee cup, painted in the manner of St Cloud with lambrequin borders, together with three other pieces (minor faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

### Condition Report

Mansfield teapot and cover - cover has tiny chip to edge and minor nicks to petals of finial, minuscule nick to tip of spout - more easily felt than seen.

Mansfield two teabowls - one badly broken and glued, other with minor chip to inner edge of foot.

Moulded teabowl - vertical haircrack and small chip to rim.

Jug and cover - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Three Flowers coffee cup and saucer - small chip to rim edge of saucer and tiny nick to rim of cup.

Lambrequin fluted cup - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Similar fluted cup - minute nick to upper rim edge.

Black printed teabowl - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Saucer with enamelled bird - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
