### LOT 1486

A Derby cobalt blue ground teacup and saucer, early 19th century, the cup painted with a 'View of Tyrol', the saucer with a 'View of Switzerland', iron red painted factory marks and script view titles, diameter of saucer 14cm, together with a similar Derby teacup and saucer, painted with 'Brough Castle' and 'Kirkstall Abbey', puce painted factory marks, a modern Spode Chelsea Bird two-handed cup, cover and stand, and a floral painted pink ground teacup.

Estimate: £50 - £80

### Condition Report

Derby Tyrol cup - overall crazing to glaze, small starcrack to base by marks, not visible to interior. Some light glaze scratches to base interior. Approx 1cm long vertical haircrack to rim by handle, fairly insignificant and only noticeable on very close inspection. Gilding and enamels overall good.

Derby Switzerland saucer - overall crazing to glaze, minor rubbing to gilt rim.

Derby Brough Castle saucer - light rubbing to gilding, otherwise ok.

Derby Kirkstall Abbey cup - light wear to gilding, otherwise ok.

Pink ground teacup - overall crazing to glaze, otherwise ok.

Spode cup, cover and stand - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
