A Royal Doulton stoneware vase, early 20th century, decorated by Hannah Barlow, monogrammed, the swollen ovoid body incised with cattle above a lobed band of stylized leaves, impressed and incised marks to base, height 20cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

There is a small area of professional restoration to the lobed lower part of the body over the darker blue edge of one of the brown centred blue leaves, it covers an area approx 1.5cm long by 0.5cm wide - it is only noticeable with a keen eye due to the fact the colour is a little different.

Otherwise the vase is in good condition.
