Condition Report

Marshall vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Rectangular vase - In good condition overall with no cracks or restoration, minor glaze chip to one of the larger faces of the vase just under part of the black painted decoration which is only noticeable on closer inspection.
