A Royal Doulton stoneware ashtray, early 20th century, the blue glazed circular body decorated with the four playing card suits, diameter 10.5cm, together with two Doulton stoneware vestas, a Doulton ashtray advertising 'Southard's London Finest Matured Rum' (chipped), another Doulton ashtray and a Watchman Series Ware jug, height 20.8cm.

Estimate: £30 - £50

Condition Report

Playing card suits ashtray - firing crack to footrim running vertically into diamond suit motif, small glaze nick to edge of footrim between club and diamond suits.

Vesta inscribed 'Shew us a light' - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Plain vesta - minor manufacturing blemish to outer edge of green rim.

Advertising ashtray - diamond shaped chip 1.5cm long by 0.5cm wide beneath the 'N' and 'D' of London, and tiny nick to edge of the well above this area.

Plain ashtray - glaze quite scratched overall, otherwise ok.

Jug - overall crazing to glaze, approx 1cm square professionally restored/filled chip to inner top rim edge which is noticeable due to colour difference.
