## LOT 1450

A mixed group of English pottery and porcelain, late 18th and 19th century, including a Mason's Patent Ironstone Imari painted potpourri with pierced domed cover, a frog mug, decorated with the Mariners Arms, height 12.2cm (restored), three ironstone plates, a pair of pearlware plates, two Spode cups and saucers and a tureen, cover and stand with brown painted mark 'H Brown Clare Hall' (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

## Condition Report

Mason's potpourri - cover broken into at least 3 large pieces and professionally restored with later glued repair to knob, the main body in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Frog mug - large area of restoration to body mainly through side of verse but visible to interior too with small touches to frog.

3 Hydra jugs - larger two are Davenport, smaller Mason's, each in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Black and white dog - typical crazing to glaze with minor glaze nicks to front edge of base, otherwise ok.

Clare Hall tureen, cover and stand - stand is crazed with some light brown staining, each piece with wear to rims, otherwise ok.

Japanese plate - broken into 2 and professionally restored.

Pair pearlware floral Imari plates - one broken into a number of pieces and professionally restored, both heavily crazed with losses to enamelled rims.

Small Mason's Imari plate - small haircrack to rim, heavily worn overall.

Davenport pink printed pot and cover - minor professional restoration to tip of spout.

Small pink printed jug - chip to footrim.

2 cups with handles 'biting' rim - one has 2 glued repairs to the handle, the other has fine crazing to the handle which also has a crack near the top of the loop, both the saucers are heavily crazed and each have a haircrack.

Continental teabowl painted with landscape views surrounded by gilding - teabowl professionally restored.

Remaining items in lot in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
