Two Dutch Delft vases and covers, early 19th century, the baluster bodies painted with a peacock by rockwork amidst flowers and foliage, within raised moulded scroll framing, the covers with Buddhist lion finials, blue painted 'B:P' marks to bases, height 40cm (some faults).

Condition Report

Fundamentally both vases and covers in good condition overall with no significant damage or repairs. Typical fritting/chips to rims and base edges.

One with small chip to footrim.

Both with typical crazing to glaze and light surface scratches/wear.
