### LOT 1514

A London Delft circular dish, circa 1740, polychrome painted with a stylized central foliate medallion, the rim with foliate detail divided by scale panels, diameter 34cm, together with a British Delft tile, painted with an urn of flowers, 13.5cm square, a 15th century Medieval jug and a white glazed jug and cover (faults and restoration).

Estimate: £40 - £60

### Condition Report

Delft dish - approx one quarter section of rim broken away and visibly glued, this is in addition to the dish already having been overall heavily restored, particularly to the rim circumference both on the upper and underside where there would appear to be a number of breaks, this restoration includes repainting and what would appear to be overall spraying.

Tile - broken in half and visibly glued with small losses along the break line. In addition there are small chips to the edges.

White jug and cover - overall fine crazing to the glaze, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Jug - extensively broken and visibly repaired with missing sections.
