## LOT 1480

A group of Coalport porcelain, late 19th century, comprising a pair of burgundy ground dishes with plated basket mounts, length 17.5cm, a pair of two-handled vases and covers with landscape views and scattered floral bouquets, height 17.5cm, two gilt ground landscape painted dishes and a pair of plates, diameter 22.7cm (faults and repairs).

## Condition Report

Pair burgundy ground dishes with plated basket mounts - first dish with overall crazing to glaze and minor chip to underside rim edge. Second dish broken into 6 pieces and visibly riveted with crazing to the glaze and small haircrack to the rim.

Pair plates - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Typical light wear to gilding and minor glaze scratches.

Pair vases and covers - one cover with glued repair to finial which includes a tiny missing section, other cover crazed. First vase crazed with branched vertical haircrack to neck approx 2cm long. Second vase crazed with light staining.

Larger gold ground dish - heavy crazing to glaze with minor staining to underside rim edge.

Smaller gold ground dish - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
