A Continental porcelain Chinese famille rose style armorial vase, probably Samson, late 19th/20th century, of baluster shape, painted to each side with an armorial incorporating crossed anchors, two flags, two birds and a crown surmounted by Shoulao, flanked by bouquets of peony and chrysanthemum, unmarked, height 21.5cm.

Estimate: £40 - £60

### Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Some light surface scratches to body and decoration primarily to widest part of body - only really noticeable on closer inspection.
