A pair of Berlin porcelain vases and covers, 19th century, each fluted barrel body decorated with floral sprays with opposing scenes of courting couples, framed within gilt and pink tied ribbon bow foliate wreaths, each cover with Prussian eagle finial, underglaze blue sceptre mark to bases, height 32cm (some faults), together with a Continental porcelain shaped square dish with floral decoration, length 24cm.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1613. 1st vase - finial has been off from main lid and has been repaired. Loss to tip of bird's beak. Very large chips to top rim of vase. Minor wear to gilding.

2nd vase - damage to bird finial, loss to wing and amateur repair to neck. Large damage and repair to base of vase, wear to gilding. Chip to top rim.

Square dish - general age related wear with surface scratches to centre.
