A Victorian gold backed, diamond and silver set brooch, designed as a stylized sword, fitted with a safety chain, unmarked, weight 10.1g, width 10.9cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

All carat weights and gradings are for guidance only, they are estimations and limited by the jewellery settings. Some variation of quality of the diamonds, ranging from SI to I clarity, some have surface reaching inclusions and a cloudy appearance.

The foldover safety catch is a later replacement. There is a pawn brokers scratch code mark at the back, very faint.

Possible alteration of the hinge from its original form, it is now raised higher than one would expect. Otherwise the piece in generally good condition.
