A platinum, emerald and diamond ring, 1950s, claw set with a graduated row of three large cut cornered rectangular step cut emeralds between curved shoulders, each mounted with a row of baguette cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 19.9g, total emerald weight approx 12.00ct, total diamond weight approx 2.00ct, ring size approx N, with a case.

Estimate: £3,000 - £5,000

Condition Report

All carat weights and gradings are for guidance only, they are estimations and limited by the jewellery settings. Total emerald weight approx 12.00ct. The emeralds are heavily included stones but of strong saturated colour. Some of the inclusions are surface reaching, the smaller of the emeralds has a surface reaching inclusion running across one corner of the stone.

Total diamond weight approx 2.00ct. Diamonds approx SI clarity, G/H colour.
The ring has been resized in the past. Otherwise the ring is in generally good condition.
