A gold, silver set and diamond ring in the Georgian taste, mounted with a row of five principal cushion cut diamonds at the centre within an openwork surround, further set with cushion cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 5.2g, ring size approx M, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

All carat weights and gradings are for guidance only, they are estimations and limited by the jewellery settings. Diamonds approx SI clarity, I/J colour.

There is an old acid test mark to the exterior of the shank, with some thinning to the back of the shank. One of the principal diamonds is at risk of coming out of its setting, a corner portion of the mount is missing. All the other diamonds look to be secure in their settings currently.
