LOT 535

An Edwardian gold, black opal and diamond necklace, the front collet set with a row of five graduated oval black opals alternating with six old mine cut diamonds, on an associated sprung hook shaped clasp, detailed '9K', weight 10.6g, length 40.7cm, with the original case.

Condition Report

Opal sizes approx. - left to right

13.8mm x 9.9mm x 3.85mm

17mm x 10mm x 5mm

16.2mm x 13.3mm x 5.1mm

16.5mm x 11mm x 4.1mm

14.5mm x 10mm x 3.6mm

Some light surface wear to the opals in places. All generally showing a blue to green play-of-colour. The length of chains attaching the sprung clasp to the rest of the necklace is also likely to be in association with the piece.

One or two chips to a couple of the diamonds. One or two claws are out of alignment. Otherwise the piece is in generally good condition.

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
