A 19th century dyed green agate hexagonal pendant fob seal, height 2.9cm, a gold, coral and half-pearl pendant, length 3.4cm, and a matching brooch, fitted with a safety chain, as converted from a pair of Victorian earrings, both unmarked, weight 7.2g.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Hexagonal fob seal - the agate has a small chip to one corner and some numbered have been scratched into the agate on one side, possibly could be polished out...

Coral and half-pearl pendant and brooch - both test better than 9ct, but we cannot be more precise than this. One coral bead on the brooch may be a later replacement as it does not match the others for colour. The two pieces are generally quite dirty and will benefit from a clean.

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
