An Edwardian silver rectangular inkstand, the raised centre fitted with two square cut glass inkwells, each with a silver collar and hinged lid, the stand with gadrooned and scallop shell rim, raised on cast scroll feet, Sheffield 1902 by Atkin Brothers, weight of stand only 376.1g, length 23.8cm.

Condition Report

308. Silver inkstand in generally good condition with typical surface scratches and wear, few very minor dents but no significant damage or repairs. One retaining nut to base missing. No obvious erasures or inscriptions. Good clear hallmarks but slightly rubbed. Inkwells fit well and hallmarks are matching. One glass bottle is cracked, both with minor chips. Both silver collars and hinges are good. Both lids with typical surface scratches and wear, and one has a small hole in the top.
