A gold ring, claw set with a cushion cut diamond, detailed '18K', weight 3g, ring size approx M, a gold, platinum and diamond three stone ring, detailed '18ct Plat', weight 2.6g, another gold ring, mounted with an oval cut citrine, detailed '9ct', and a 9ct two colour gold, blue and colourless gem set eternity ring, total weight 3.6g.

Estimate: £120 - £160

Condition Report

Gold and diamond single stone - possibly mid-20th century, some thinning to the back of the shank. Diamond weight approx. 0.15ct.

Three stone diamond ring - ring size approx N. Some wear to the sides of the setting where it has been worn with other rings, possibly first half 20th century.

Citrine ring - the citrine is uneven in its setting and at risk of becoming loose, the citrine is heavily included. The head of the ring may have started life as something else, the shank has been poorly attached at the sides, very thin at these points. Due to the depth of the citrine is not possible to provide an accurate ring size. Weight 1.1g.

Eternity ring - general abrasion to the stones. Ring size approx H. Weight 2.5g

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
