A Chinese Transitional blue and white porcelain jar, mid-17th century, the swollen ovoid body painted with two birds perched in blossoming branches beside bamboo, rocks and insects, all beneath a leaf band to neck, height 12cm (minor rim chips and firing crack to base), together with a carved and pierced hardwood stand and cover (lacking finial).

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

1055. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Two minor shallow chips to rim, typical light surface scratches to glaze. There is a firing crack around the inside of the footrim, this is not a fault but in the manufacture. Two minor nicks to footrim. Wood stand in good condition. Cover missing its finial, otherwise ok.
