Condition Report

1265. Both in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

The two equestrian paintings both have horizontal creases to the paper, as well as some minor discolouration and scuffs and both have small areas of damp staining.

The two with figures kicking a ball both have horizontal creases to paper and some minor discolouration.

Painting and calligraphy is generally good.
