LOT 1003

A pair of Chinese famille rose export porcelain plates, Yongzheng period, each painted with a central peony and flower spray within a rim of further flowers, diameter 22.5cm (one with starcrack, the other with wear to enamels), together with another famille rose plate, Yongzheng period, painted with flowers emanating from rocks within a floral and whorl rim, diameter 22.6cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1003. Plate 1 - starcrack to base and typical light surface scratches and wear to glaze and enamels.

Plate 2 - small 2cm hairline near to the footrim in the centre of the plate and wear and loss to some enamels, otherwise no chips or repairs.

Other plate - there is a faint 2.2cm hairline to rim, otherwise in good condition with no chips or repairs. Typical wear and scratches to glaze and enamels.
