### LOT 1264

A collection of Chinese export porcelain, mostly Qianlong period, including an Imari meat dish, painted with a maiden and boy on a pond-side terrace, length 33.5cm (restored), two blue and white meat dishes, each painted with coastal landscape, lengths 41cm, plates, soup plates and teaware (faults and restoration).

### Condition Report

1264. Imari meat dish - restored.

Blue and white meat dish 1 - broken in half and restored.

Blue and white meat dish 2 - broken in half and restored.

All five of the blue and white octagonal dishes are cracked or restored.

Famille rose plate - rim chips and wear to decoration.

Famille rose bowl decorated with deer and cattle - two vertical hairlines (3.5cm and 4cm) to rim, otherwise good condition.

Blue and white teabowl and saucer - teabowl in good condition, saucer cracked.

Small blue and white plate (16.2cm diameter), chip to rim.

Two blue and white saucers - small one with hairline crack to rim, larger one with some minor rim chips and hairline to rim.
