LOT 1213

A collection of Chinese porcelain, late 19th century and later, including a Canton famille rose vase, painted with birds, butterflies and flowers within yellow borders filled with lotus and tendrils, height 35.5cm (repaired), a famille verte ginger jar and cover, painted with peony and leafy tendrils, height 15cm (cover repaired), eight famille rose celadon ground dishes and two crackle glaze vases (some faults).

Condition Report

1213. Large yellow ground vase - approx 2/3rds of rim broken and re-glued with some chips and losses along the breaks. Small starcrack to base. Otherwise body of the vase in generally good condition with typical light wear and scratches.

Famille verte ginger jar - good condition, the cover is broken in half, re-glued and with chip to rim.

Two crackle glazed vases - generally good condition, typical wear, no covers.

Crackled ginger jar - generally good but typical wear, some glaze discolouration, no cover.

'Clobbered' blue and white vase - crack to base, chips to rim and neck, chipping to glaze and enamels on neck and shoulder, typical wear, no cover.

Famille rose dish (16.6cm diameter) - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Three small celadon ground dishes (14.8cm diameters) - one chipped and cracked, two cracked and all with surface scratches and wear to enamels.

Five mid sizes celadon ground dishes (approx 18.5cm diameters) - one chipped, cracked and repaired. One chipped to rim. Three with rim chips and cracks. All with surface scratches, wear to enamels.
