### LOT 1101

A group of five Chinese gilt decorated blue and white export porcelain circular dishes, Kangxi period, each painted in underglaze blue with birds, rocks and peony, further embellished with gilt and iron red birds and bamboo, all within floral filled rims, comprising a pair, diameters 34.5cm (both repaired), a smaller dish, diameter 30.5cm, and a pair of plates, diameter 23cm (minor chips and glaze fritting to rims).

Estimate: £300 - £500

### Condition Report

1101. Large dish 1 (34.5cm diameter) - broken into three pieces and repaired with signs of old filled rivet holes. 6.5cm hairline to rim, starcrack to centre and wear to gilt and enamel decoration. Fritting to glaze of rim.

Large dish 2 (34.5cm diameter) - 'U' shaped section of rim broken out and rivet repaired (4.5cm x 17cm). Also some minor chips and fritting to glaze on rim. Typical wear to gilt and enamels.

Mid sized dish (30.5cm diameter) - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs, typical rim fritting to glaze. Typical minor wear and surface scratches to gilt, enamels and glaze.

Two smaller plates (23cm diameter) - both in generally good condition but with typical glaze fritting and chips to rims and wear to gilt and enamels.
