LOT 1031

A Chinese blue and white export porcelain plate, 18th century, painted with a pavilion and pagoda in a coastal landscape, diameter 23.2cm (minor rim chips), together with a Canton famille rose enamelled celadon ground porcelain dessert dish, mid to late 19th century, painted with birds, butterflies and flowers, length 25.5cm, and three similarly decorated smaller plates, diameters 18.9cm to 19.2cm (minor chips and hairlines).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1031. Blue and white plate - generally good condition but with minor rim chips.

Dessert dish - two minor chips to rim and typical wear to enamels and gilt rim.

Side plate 1 - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical wear to enamels.

Side plate 2 - 1.7cm hairline to rim and small chip to rim. Typical light wear to enamels and glaze.

Side plate 3 - very small chip to rim, otherwise good condition. Typical minor wear to enamels.
