A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, late 19th century, with cylindrical body and flared neck, painted with deer beneath pine, height 23.5cm (faults), a Chinese blue and white porcelain ginger jar and cover, mark of Kangxi but late 19th century, painted with prunus, underglaze blue four-character mark to base, height 15cm, a provincial bowl, diameter 15cm, and a small group of other wares, including a pair of vases and covers, painted with prunus, a Japanese vase and a Japanese circular dish (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1259 - Cylindrical vase - Numerous small chips to rim and two small hairline/glaze blemishes around rim (each approx 2.8cm long). Otherwise body in good condition.

Pair of ginger jars - One with faint star crack to base and one cover with minor chip repair to rim. Otherwise in good condition.

Prunus ginger jar with Kangxi mark - Good condition, small hairline (1.5cm long to rim of cover).

Small prunus jar - Good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Japanese dish - Good condition.

Japanese blue and white jar - Good condition, no cover.

Bowl - Repaired chip to rim, crazing to glaze.

Three small blue and white cups - One cracked, other two ok.
