Condition Report

2466. Condition is generally good, but there is an internal hairline running from the pontil. Our belief is that this is a Roman bottle, it was described by Christies in 1970 as Romano-British and possibly from Horsham. The last time it came up at auction it was wrongly catalogued as 'Medieval'.
