A gold and silver set, diamond and enamelled pendant, designed as a bird in flight beside a foliate spray, mounted with rose cut diamonds, unmarked, weight 9.5g, length 3.6cm, with a case.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

The piece probably started life as a brooch, but the fittings are now lacking.

There is some restoration to the enamel work in several places, the wings, the head and to the foliate wreath.

There is a loss either of a leaf or a diamond and its setting directly below the head of the bird.

Circa 1900, possibly European.

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
