LOT 585

A gold, emerald and diamond ring, 1950s/60s, mounted with the rectangular step cut emerald between diamond set stepped shoulders, unmarked, weight 6.1g, ring size approx Q1/2, with a Garrard & Co case.

Estimate: £350 - £450

Condition Report

All carat weights and gradings are for guidance only, they are estimations and limited by the jewellery settings. Total diamond weight approx. 1.00ct.

The diamonds are old cut stones and so have some variety of shape. Generally SI clarity, I/J colour. Emerald weight approx. 1.80-2.00ct. The emerald has a couple of surface reaching inclusions.

There is no certificate for this ring outlining any further details regarding the stones. The piece is unmarked, so we cannot be certain of its grade of gold.

The shank has a dent/split to one shoulder (evident in image 3 on our website), typical light surface scratching otherwise.

The Garrard & Co case we feel is in association with the ring.

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
