### Condition Report

12. Relined, cleaned and restored. Paint a little thin in areas. A few small dents to the surface. Craquelure throughout. UV examination highlights considerable overpainting throughout, including most of the grey cloud in the sky. Varnish is quite flat.

Gilt frame repainted or varnished. Minor chips and scuffs to extremities.
