A late 19th century French ormolu and Sèvres style porcelain mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the circular enamelled dial with blue Roman hour numerals and black outer Arabic minutes, inscribed 'Raingo Fres a Paris', the case with flower surmount above a pair of doves and foliate scrolls, inset with turquoise bordered porcelain panels painted with Cupid and flowers, on a similarly decorated integral stand, height 40cm, with pendulum and key.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1198. Clock in good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. Case is good and porcelain panels all appear to be good with fresh vibrant painting and gilding. Both hinged doors are good. Dial has minor chips around winding holes, otherwise good. Both trains of the movement wind and it starts working, but only runs for a few minutes before stopping.

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
