A late 19th century French bronze, marble and brass mounted sleeping Napoleon mantel timepiece, the movement with platform escapement, housed within a brown patinated bronze orb shaped case with applied gilt Roman hour numerals and surmounted with imperial eagle, flanked by a brown patinated bronze figure of a seated Napoleon with arms folded and left foot resting on a gilt barrel, the rectangular marble base applied with brass classical figures, trophies of war and festoons, on foliate capped paw feet, height 31cm.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1160. Clock in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Bit dirty and dusty so would benefit from a clean. Small shallow chip to front edge of marble plinth (see image 5 on our website) and a few other minor nicks to marble edges, but nothing too significant.

The movement winds but it is not currently running. The clock and case are unsigned. There is a key with this clock.
