A George III silver pair cased keywind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement and pierced and engraved foliate balance cock, the backplate detailed 'M.A. Coles London N.424511', the enamelled dial with Roman hour numerals, London 1790, outer case diameter 5.2cm.

The movement winds smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Dial with a faint hairline between 11 o'clock and 1 o'clock, and another hairline from 6 to 8 o'clock.

Both cases with typical light surface scratches and wear, but no significant damage. Couple of minor dents to case backs.

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
