LOT 1190

A late Victorian ebonized and gilt brass mounted bracket clock with eight day triple fusee movement chiming quarters on a nest of nine bells and striking hours on a gong, the backplate and pendulum with engraved foliate decoration, the brass breakarch dial with silvered chime/silent and chime selection subsidiary dials to arch above a silvered chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals and outer Arabic minutes, matt centre and cast and pierced foliate spandrels, the case with foliate finials above a moulded arch pediment, glazed door and herm corner columns, drop handles and pierced fret panels to sides, on a moulded rectangular plinth base and cast foliate feet, height 53.5cm, with matching wall bracket, pendulum and winding key.

Condition Report

1190. The clock is in generally good condition and of its type a nice original clock. The substantial movement appears to run ok although both striking and chiming trains are jammed. They are both fully wound but do not strike at present. Movement is in good clean condition, but will require some attention to return to full working order. Case in generally good order with some minor chips and nicks. Nice original winding key.
