LOT 1231

A 19th century mahogany regulator style longcase clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the 12-inch brass dial with subsidiary seconds and date aperture, inscribed 'Henry Lamport Plymo Docks', the domed top case with glazed door and sides, mirrored back and panelled base on bun feet, height 192cm (alterations and faults, lacking pendulum and weights).

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

1231. The clock is an amateur 'made-up' longcase clock made to look like a regulator. The mechanism is a standard brass movement with no deadbeat escapement and the dial has been cut down to fit the case. Lacking pendulum and weights. It does have a good pair of regulator style pulleys. Case with changed panel to base and major split to front door frame. Top of case lifts off to give access to movement.
