A late 19th/early 20th century gilt metal mounted marble portico clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the circular enamelled dial with Roman hour numerals, the case with gilt lion surmount above four columns and serpentine plinth, height 38.4cm, with sunburst pendulum, together with a pair of gilt metal and alabaster urn cassettes on plinth bases, height 20.8cm.

### Condition Report

1206. Clock in generally good order, typical minor nicks and scuffs to marble, but no significant damage or repairs. Metalwork in generally good order, lion looks like it has been regilded. Dial with repaired chip around winding hole. The movement winds smoothly and runs, striking mechanism also in working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

Both alabaster urns in good condition wth minor nicks/chips to edges.
