### LOT 1409

A rare Wedgwood Moonlight lustre pottery part dessert service, early 19th century, each piece of shell shape and covered in a mottled pink, orange and grey glaze, comprising a tureen and cover with stand and ladle, a dish and four scallop plates, impressed marks (minor faults).

Estimate: £200 - £300

### Condition Report

Tureen and cover - cover with 8.5cm haircrack running width ways to one side of knob with approx 2mm square flat chip to upper edge alongside where the haircrack emanates, very minor and indistinct glaze fritting to rim edge. Tureen itself with approx 1cm square flat chip to front edge of foot.

Tureen stand - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Ladle - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Dish - very small chip to underside edge of one back corner, surface scratches to glaze of dish well, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

First plate - starcrack approx 12cm long at its longest point, otherwise ok.

Second plate - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Third plate - small chip to footrim, minor glaze fritting to rim edge.

Fourth plate - very minor chip to footrim.
