A Moorcroft Pottery circular dish, 1920s, decorated with the Pansy pattern against a blue ground, impressed marks and green painted signature to base, diameter 32cm (restored), together with a Royal Doulton jug, decorated by Emily Partington, monogrammed, with flowers against a textured ground, height 14cm.

## Condition Report

Moorcroft - an approx one quarter 'slice' of the bowl has been broken away in one large piece and some smaller sections and professionally restored, with other areas of professional restoration to the rim circumference. The restoration is noticeable primarily to the underside due to the absence of crazing along the break lines and differences in colour to the blue ground.

Doulton jug - crack to lower handle terminal and minor nick to one small section of raised tubelining.
