A Worcester underglaze blue printed Fence pattern coffee pot and cover, circa 1770, hatched crescent in underglaze blue to base, height 22cm, a Davenport bat printed teacup and saucer, a Chinese export ware Qianlong period teapot and cover, painted in the famille rose palette, three Qianlong period Chinese blue and white plates and two other pieces (faults and restoration).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Coffee pot - body of coffee pot in generally good condition with small flat chip to inner rim edge where cover sits and minor nicks to tip of spout, the cover has a made-up replacement knob and a small approx 1.5cm long by 1cm deep area of restoration to the upper rim edge.

Wedgwood caneware teapot and cover - missing end of spout, otherwise ok.

Unmarked buff plate - 2 chips to footrim, otherwise ok.

Davenport teacup and saucer - saucer finely crazed, otherwise both pieces ok.

3 Chinese blue and white plates - one badly cracked and chipped, one broken in half and glued with old rivet holes, one broken in half and professionally restored.

Chinese teapot and cover - main body badly cracked with some attempts at restoration.
