A pair of pink opaline French glass vases, early 20th century, of tapered oval shape on circular feet, enamelled and gilt to one side with flowers, foliage and scrollwork, height 30cm, together with a Vianne French glass vase and six press moulded vases in the form of hands holding cornucopia, height of tallest 30cm.

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

One of the pink vases has some very minor nibbling to the top rim edge - otherwise both pink vases are in good condition overall with typical light rubbing to the gilding.

The green hand cornucopia has a small vertical chip to the mould line on one side edge of the base, and some minor nicks to the edge of the foot, otherwise all the hand vases are in good condition.

The Vianne vase has some incredibly tiny nicks to the inner top rim edge, more easily felt than seen, otherwise is ok.
