A Daniel porcelain part service, circa 1820-30, pattern No. 4073, comprising teapot, cover and stand, jug, slop bowl, eight teacups, four coffee cups and six saucers (minor faults).

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

Teapot - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The teapot cover is crazed and lightly stained, giving it a creamy appearance when placed on the teapot.

Teapot stand - light typical surface scratches.

Jug - finely crazed with light staining and some fine haircracks.

Slop - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Saucers - each with rubbing to the gilding of the wells, 4 ok, one cracked and one finely crazed and stained.

Coffee cups - 3 with minor haircracks, one crazed and stained.

Teacups - 6 ok, one with crack, one with minor hairline, each with typical rubbing to gilding.
